The ability of the supported party to engage in gainful employment without unduly interfering with the interests of dependent children in the custody of the party. (§ 4320(g).)

The age and health of the parties. (§ 4320(h).)

Documented evidence of any history of domestic violence, as defined in Section 6211 between the parties, including, but not limited to, consideration of emotional distress resulting from domestic violence perpetrated against the supported party by the supporting party, and consideration of any history of violence against the supporting party by the supported party. (§ 4320(i).)
